

HISTORY OF THE LIBRARY

Opened in 1895, the Library was a non-profit corporation trust under the direction of a seven member Board of Trustees. From 1895 until 1955, all Library expenses were paid by the Trustees and bequests. Since 1955, town funding has paid for salaries, operating expenses, all reading materials and supplies.

The Library building itself is owned and maintained by the Trustees with all capital expenses paid from the Trustees and not from Town funding.

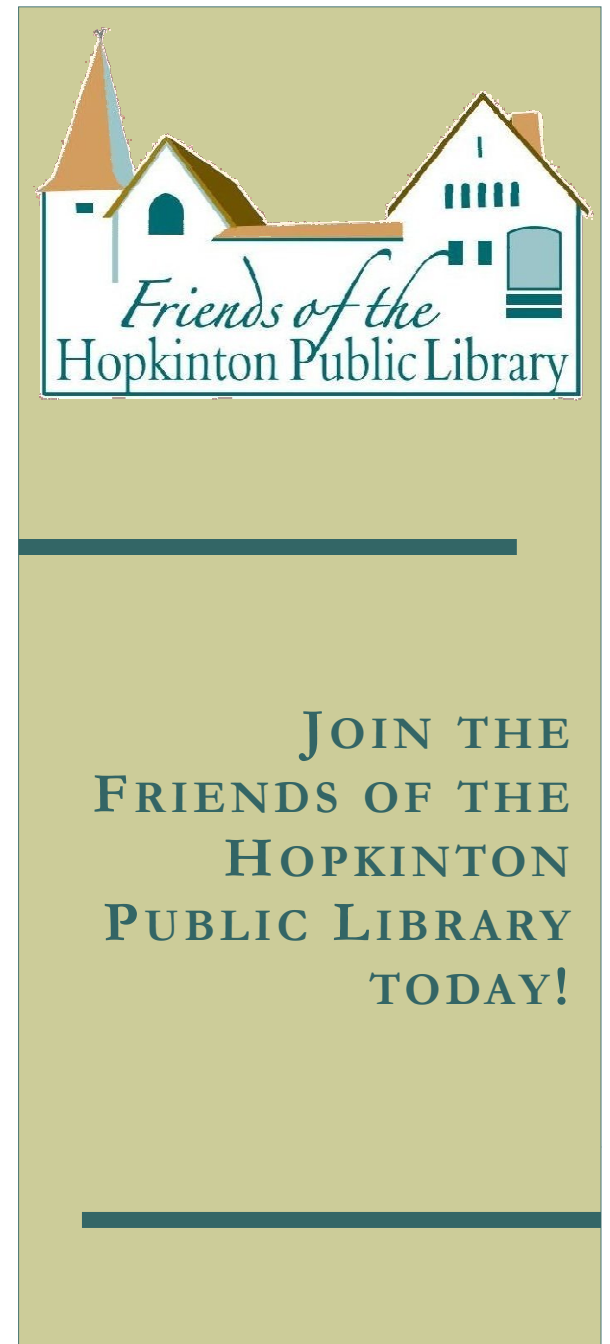
